

Samuel Wilberforce

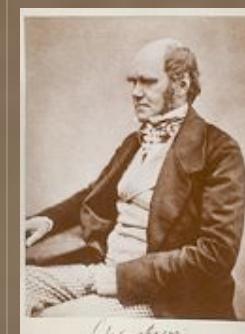
1805 A.D. – 1873 A.D.



Chaplain to Prince Albert and Bishop of Oxford, Wilberforce participated in an well-publicized debate with Thomas Huxley on Darwin's theory.

Charles Robert Darwin

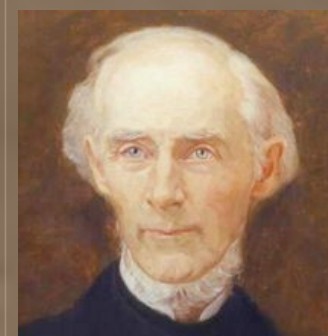
1809 A.D. – 1882 A.D.



Developed a theory of evolution in which all species descended from common ancestors.

Richard Owen

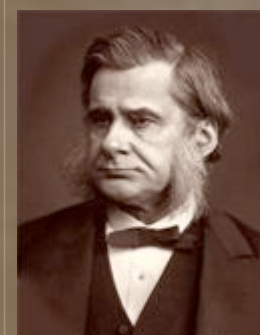
1810 A.D. – 1890 A.D.



President of Purdue University and geologist who originally supported, then criticized Darwin's theories.

Thomas Huxley

1825 A.D. – 1895 A.D.



English biologist who supported Darwin and debated with Samuel Wilberforce.

John Hall Gladstone

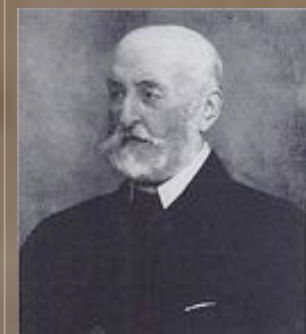
1827 A.D. – 1902 A.D.



Chemist who attempted to reconcile Scripture with Natural Science in the wake of Darwin's publications.

St. George Jackson Mivart

1827 A.D. – 1900 A.D.



English biologist who began as a support of natural selection but ended as a fierce opponent of Darwin.
