1785 A.D. – 1851 A.D.



American painter and naturalist whose works captured and preserved the wildlife of the American frontier.

John Muir

1838 A.D. – 1914 A.D.



American frontiersman and naturalist who wrote about the beauties of Yosemite, the Grand Canyon, and Mount Rainier. His conservation efforts led to the establishment of the National Park system.

Rachel Carson

1907 A.D. – 1964 A.D.



American marine biologist and naturalist whose studies of the effects of synthetic pesticides lead to the bans on DDT and recognition of the complex interplay between organisms in ecological systems.
